MINUTES OF MEETING

ATTENDEES: Mark Herbert, Ralph Stillions, Susan Mueller, Julie Breland, Shaula Hailey, Barbara McDonald, Mary Berry, Beverly Herbert and Steve Downs

Chairman Mark Herbert presided and opened with prayer.

Ralph Stillions gave the Treasurer's report, stating there is about \$3,500 on hand. He has requested \$12,000 from the Diocese for 2007.

Susan Mueller reported that the new storage shed at Gray Center needs to be organized and inventoried. She will try to obtain additional shelving and will set up a Work Day for volunteers to organize the space.

Following discussion of the request from Gray Center for the Secretariat to donate \$2,000 for the storage shed in four payments, the Secretariat voted to give \$1,000 in one payment and have rights to the shed in perpetuity.

Susan Mueller was chosen as the Rector for Cursillo #113.

Ralph Stillions asked the group to consider persons to suggest for vacant Servant Community Positions. Julie Breland volunteered to handle paper supplies; Shaula Hailey agreed to take over Cursillo Specialty Items; and Mark Herbert agreed to be in charge of Weekend Rector Training. The group agreed to eliminate the positions of Hospitality and Kairos and to change Computer Editor/Records to Historian.

Mark and Beverly Herbert agreed to form a committee to coordinate a function to honor Robin Dow, possibly in conjunction with a Reunion.

Mary Berry reported that the Bishop spoke favorably at length about Cursillo at the Clergy Conference and that he will participate in #116.

In response to the deactivation of the West Tennessee Cursillo movement, Ralph will ask the Bishop to invite the members to join in the Mississippi activities.

Ralph presented his vision for what he would like to see accomplished during his term as Chairman, and Mark presented his advice as outgoing chairman including "don't be guided by 'we've always done it that way'."

The meeting was adjourned with a closing prayer.
